


Population by Age Group (2015 Boone County)









Boone County Child Poverty Rate






Children Living in Neighborhoods with Poverty Rate Higher than 30%





Missouri Resident Emergency Room Heroin Discharges 2015




Missouri Resident Emergency Room Non-Heroin Opioid Discharges 2015







Child Mortality (Ages 1-17)






Mental/Behavioral Hospitalizations (not substance abuse) Ages 1-19





Youth Mental Health Emergency Room Rates


Boone County Youth Mental Health Rate (Up to Age 24)



Boone County Youth Mental Health Rate (Under 15)




Boone County High Schools Attendance Rates by Race (2014 & 2017)






School Attendance: % of Students Attending at Least 90% of School Days (Columbia Public Schools)









Columbia Schools Graduation Rate by Race (Adjusted 4 Years)



High School Graduation Rate by School District (Adjusted 4 Years)




Boone County # of Unaccompanied Youth by School District (School Year 2012-2013 Through School Year 2016-2017)









Children's Division: Out-of-Home Placements





Boone County Out-of-Home Placements: Children Exiting Children's Division Custody and Placement Category at Time of Exit
